Fourth, God sent gigantic swarms of flies to the Egyptians, but not to the Hebrew slaves. Can you imagine what it must have been like to have thousands of flies covering their bodies? I'll bet everyone even had maggots in their hair!

Fifth, God allowed every Egyptian sheep, donkey, horse, camel, and all of the cattle that were in the fields to get a horrible disease and die. This sounds a little like Covid-19 doesn't?

Sixth, God made everyone's skin including the animals; erupt with oozing sores called boils. I'll bet they all were in horrible pain!

Seventh, God made it thunder; fire zinged and huge hunks of hail came down from the sky. It was the complete opposite of a beautiful display of fireworks. Trees were shattered, crops were destroyed and even many of the people and animals that were outside died.

### Exodus 14-15:1
